- If you export more than one film to a mini-dv tape, please label the order the films appear in correctly.

RULES & JUDGING CRITERIA FOR BEST ACTOR & ACTRESS IN A SHORT FILM

- Best Actor & Actress categories will be judged from the performances delivered in the Junior & Senior Short Film Sections.

RULES FOR CLAY MODEL AND GRAPHIC ANIMATION

- Create a clay model animation or graphic animation based on **Nga Haka me nga Waiata o Ngati Porou**
- All animations **must be no longer than 3 minutes.**
- Clay animations may be created by animating clay or plasticine models created by students. PLEASE NOTE THE CLAY OR PLASTICINE MODELS MUST BE CREATED BY STUDENTS

- Graphic animations may be created by animating computer graphics designed by students.
- All animations must be supplied as HIGH QUALITY AVI FILES, MPEG FILES or QUICKTIME FILES.
- Please note in the Pipi Nati & Senior Sections the Animation section is combined. In the Junior Section Clay Model & Graphic Animations will be judged separately.
- Please create 1 copy of all your schools animation entries and download to CD, DVD, Memory Stick or Mac-Compatible External Hard-drive.

RULES FOR DIGITAL PHOTO

- Create one digital photo based on **Nga Haka me nga Waiata o Ngati Porou**
- The photo will be judged on its relevance to the kaupapa/theme, visual composition and aesthetic appeal.
- The photo must be saved in JPEG format file (over 500kb gives good quality) and the file will be named using the title of the photo and the name of the photographer.
- Photos **MUST NOT BE** digitally enhanced.
- Please upload all your schools JPEG files on one CD -Rom or Memory Stick.
- **PLEASE NOTE: ONLY 10 ENTRIES PER SECTION ACCEPTED FROM EACH SCHOOL**

RULES FOR GRAPHIC DESIGN POSTER

- Create a graphic design poster based on **Nga Haka me nga Waiata o Ngati Porou**
- Encourage students to be creative in their visual interpretation of the theme.
- Posters will be judged on basic design elements, aesthetic appreciation and relevance to the theme.
- Posters can be created using Photo shop, Publisher or other graphic design programmes.
- Poster to be **A4 or A3 size**.
- Please supply **1 hard copy** of each poster entry.

RULES FOR ORIGINAL MUSIC COMPOSITION

- Create an original music composition based on **Nga Haka me nga Waiata o Ngati Porou**
- Original music compositions **MUST** include lyrics.
- The lyrics and music must be the students own **ORIGINAL** creation and must be performed by students attending NPEC Schools.
- Original music compositions must be created or recorded using a computer programme (e.g. Garage Band/Pro Tools)
- Real instruments may be connected to the computer.
- **Please attach typed or clearly written lyrics and some information** about the song.
- Please supply **1 copy** of all your schools music entries on CD Rom format.
- Please supply songs on **MP3 format only** - if you need to convert into MP3 format there are many freeware programmes downloadable from the net –Try <http://www.zamzar.com/> it seems to do the trick). **Other formats ie. WMA WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.**

PIPI NATI CATEGORY RULES YEAR 1-3

- Power point/Slide show -
 - 6 slides with no text except for first slide.
 - Only one transition between each slide
 - No animations on the slide eg extra pictures sliding in or appearing
 - Time limit of 30 seconds maximum
 - Music or Sound in background is acceptable
 - Please convert final slide show presentations to Standard MPEG, QUICKTIME OR AVI FORMAT. **Other formats will not be accepted due to compatibility issues.**

Y1-3 can still enter other categories but each entry can only be entered into 1 section

RULES FOR SCRIPT

- Create a Script based on **Nga Haka me nga Waiata o Ngati Porou**
- Scripts must be for a short film in Te Reo or English.
- Scripts must follow script formatting guidelines. See websites below ie. Scriptarama, Huia, Celx.com etc for examples.
- The submitted scripts can be
 - the shooting scripts (before the film is made)
 - the transcripts (after the film is made)
 - for a film that has not been created.
- Entries will be judged on relevance to the theme, story, character, structure, originality, dialogue/narration, and overall rating of the entire script.
